

Band Camp Student Information Sheet:

is a list of items that all students need to have with them each day throughout band camp. These items are NEEDED AT ALL TIMES and are intended to keep everyone as healthy, happy and productive as possible!

- Water (1/2 Gallon jug or larger)
- Sunscreen
- Lip Balm with SPF (sun block) protection
- Hat
- Comfortable and supportive shoes for marching and movement
- Comfortable clothing rehearsal in all possible weather conditions (heat, cold, rain, wind)
- Instrument/Equipment in good condition (proper reeds, mouthpieces, sticks, flags, etc.)
- Music Folder (3-ring binder with plastic sheets)
- Pencils
- Bug Spray
- Bag Lunch (when needed – see below)

Students are responsible for their own lunches throughout band camp. It is recommended that students pack a lunch and eat at CPHS to avoid excess driving and eat healthy!

The Champlin Park Band Association will be providing dinners during the second week of camp. Thanks to Dan Wotzka and all of the volunteers who are helping to provide these meals for our students.
